"Strengthening health system response to Adolescent Health Services program" This project aims to empower adolescents and youth by equipping them with the knowledge and tools to make informed decisions about their reproductive health. The initiative focuses on delivering reliable, age-appropriate education on family planning, sexual and reproductive health (SRH) and the harmful consequences of child marriage.



The primary project activities for Iraq and the Kurdistan Region of Iraq (KRI) include:



 Awareness Sessions (AG): Conducting awareness sessions on sexual and reproductive health empowerment, family planning, and early marriage in schools, youth centers, and communities across three governorates in the Kurdistan Region.



 Training of Trainers (TOT): Enhancing the capacities of staff from health centers and social workers in Iraqi governorates in collaboration with the Ministry of Health in Iraq and KRI.



 Provision of Equipment: Purchasing a laptop for the Ministry of Health in the Kurdistan Region to be used in public health departments and health centers.



Training of Trainers: Providing training for social workers from the Ministry
of Education in schools on family planning, sexual and reproductive health,
and child marriage prevention, using a specialized training manual for
adolescent girls in Iraqi governorates and the Kurdistan Region.



 Braille Booklets: Producing and printing Braille booklets containing awareness messages on sexual and reproductive health, child marriage prevention, and family planning, for a institution from the Ministry of Social Affairs and Labor.



• **Health Awareness Brochures:** Printing and distributing health awareness brochures on puberty stages for boys and girls in collaboration with the Ministry of Education in the Kurdistan Region.

"INNOVATIVE EDUCATION AND PEACEFUL LIVING ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN IRAQ "

The primary outcome of this project is to advance the realization of the Right to Education and the right to safe living environments for children and youth, with a particular focus on girls and persons with disabilities. This will be achieved by:

- Strengthening the capacity and sustainability of rights-holders and duty-bearers within partner organizations to act innovatively in promoting the rights of children and youth.
- Expanding collaboration with the Government sector to foster innovative solutions and develop new approaches to addressing challenges.

THE MAIN ACTIVITIES:



 Teacher Training: Equip educators with active learning techniques for all educational stages.



• **Sustainability Advocacy:** Build networks and committees to integrate sustainability into education without curriculum changes.



 Children's Workshops: Teach environmental and leadership skills while celebrating international days.



 Volunteer Awareness: Promote volunteerism among schools, teachers, and youth.



 Special Needs Support: Provide tools and resources for active learning in special education.

MASAROUNA PROJECT



MASAROUNA project implemented through collaboration with Oxfam and with support from the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

MASAROUNA amplifies the voices of young people in the Middle East and North Africa to advocate for their sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), paving the way for progress through influence and civil society empowerment.

PRIMARY ACTIVITIES OF OXFAM'S PARTNER:

Religious Leaders Training:

Trained religious leaders to deliver health messages on SRH, including adolescent health, pre-marital counseling, STDs, family planning, and contraceptive use.

Brochure Distribution:

Distributed brochures to youth on SRH, family planning, menstrual hygiene, and pad usage.

Online Sessions:

Conducted virtual SRH sessions for youth via Zoom for broader outreach.

Youth Awareness Sessions:

Held sessions in Erbil and nearby areas (universities, schools, community centers, camps, health facilities) on menstrual health, STDs, body awareness, and early marriage.


















